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APPLICANT QUESTIONNAIRE

1. Why do you want to be appointed to the City of Morgan Hill City Council?

I want to be appointed to the City of Morgan Hill City Council because I have the experience, education, passion, and demeanor to serve my community in a meaningful way.

I grew up in Morgan Hill, attending Jackson Elementary, Britton Middle School, and Live Oak High School. My father has been a small business owner in Morgan Hill for as long as I can remember, and I moved my young family back here to have the same quality of life we enjoyed growing up. While the state of our national affairs continues to become more and more volatile and contentious, I feel it is my duty to do my part to protect and enrich our community. With my background, education, and experience, I feel I would best be of service on the City Council to help foster relationships with the public and provide a voice for young, working families.

2. What qualifies you to serve on the Morgan Hill City Council?

First, my 19+ years in Morgan Hill provide the most important qualification, as I know and love our town. But besides being a long-time resident, I also have ventured out to gain the education and experience I needed to come home and serve our community fully. I entered law school at Santa Clara because I was specifically interested in policy. While in law school, I clerked at the Panetta Institute for Public Policy, worked alongside County Counsel Ann Ravel, and clerked at the District Attorney's Office.

I have learned that when you work in policy, you are often required to become an expert on a wide range of issues, sometimes on a moment's notice. I have gained the experience necessary to be able to educate myself quickly and thoroughly on new challenges. My training and background give me the ability to know what questions to ask and how to research an issue to be able to competently make meaningful decisions.

My qualifications go beyond the academic. As a new lawyer, I worked as an assistant to Congresswoman Zoe Lofgren, and quickly became a Commissioner on the Parks and Recreation Commission for Santa Clara County. While working for Congress, I was based in the local office, focused on the unique challenges of our region with daily contact with constituents. Accompanying the Congresswoman on countless meetings, interviews, speeches, and discussions - I learned what matters to people in our beautiful valley, and how to work with regional partners to address our issues.

Being a Commissioner has taught me that the most important qualification for participation on a local decision making body is the ability to listen. It is imperative that the council does not just bring their own agenda to the table, but really listens to both the public and the paid staff giving input on an issue.

Finally, I am a wife, and the mother of a young daughter. I am qualified to serve on the Morgan Hill City Council because I represent not only the history of our town, but also our future. My interest in the health, safety, and success of Morgan Hill is intensely personal, because it means the success of my friends, family, teachers, and mentors.

3. What are your top three priorities for the City of Morgan Hill?

As I previously mentioned, I believe that a Councilmember's top priority should be to marry the needs and wants of the public with the expertise of staff. But as a private citizen, my top three priorities are all connected and could be best summarized the following ways:

1) Safety- Of course, my number one priority for our city is the health and safety of all of our citizens. This relates not only to reduction of crime, and safety of our large community events, but also safety in our cars and on the roads as the traffic in our region continues to worsen. The traffic we are experiencing around rush hours is a safety issue, and we need to come up with long-term solutions to the growing problem.

2) Scenery- I believe that our open spaces and our location are what make Morgan Hill the greatest city on earth. While we do have a duty to house people and do our part to make sure our children can grow up to live in our community, we can't sacrifice the environment to do so.

3) Success- In order for our town to be successful, we need to be thriving! We need businesses to be thriving, schools to be performing, and our citizens to be happy members of an active community. Morgan Hill has such a wonderful sense of community, we need to continue to support each other by helping our businesses and our schools flourish.

I believe these goals are connected, as our success depends on our safety and our ability to manage the growth of our town in a sustainable way, while developing the infrastructure needed to sustain our growth without losing the open spaces and natural resources that enrich our quality of life.

4. Why should you be appointed to serve on the Morgan Hill City Council?

I hope that it is clear from my application and resume that I am hardworking, and passionate about our home. I have dedicated my precious time away from my family to be of service to members of my community. If appointed, I will bring my education, experience, and passion to the council table. But what may not be as evident from my application is that I love people and I am great in a meeting. What I mean is that I pride myself on being able to find common ground in an appropriate and efficient way.

In Morgan Hill, our home is our uniting factor. I believe I should be appointed because I have the best interests of the common citizen in mind, because I am one. 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

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APPLICANT QUESTIONNAIRE

1. Why do you want to be appointed to the City of Morgan Hill City Council?

First, I love my community and have always had a strong desire for public service. I have contemplated running for various offices and committees and that was on my list for 2017, so this opportunity is timely.

Second, and most importantly, I want to build and maintain a safe environment where my children (6 and 4) can be play, grow and succeed. I recognize that I cannot do that alone or by focusing solely on my family. To truly provide for my family, I recognize the need to engage the community and have a voice in it. I truly believe it takes a village to raise a family. We rely on the public schools for educating our children, for strong public safety departments to keep us safe, for emergency preparedness, for parks and recreation, etc. Thus, I want to be a leader to work as a team within the Morgan Hill community to provide the guidance needed to ensure the safe and secure environment in which we can all raise our kids.

Third, I want to set an example for our community and for my kids. You cannot make a difference unless you are involved. Sitting on the sidelines is not an option if you want to have an impact in your community. That is why I have strived most of my adult life to some sort of public service; from the military to my time as a sworn peace officer to my dedication to the practice of law.

For these reasons, and many more, I hope to be appointed to the City of Morgan Hill City Council.

2. What qualifies you to serve on the Morgan Hill City Council?

I have a very diverse background that qualifies me for serving on the Morgan Hill City Council. My qualifications are best summarized as follows:

Education:

- University of San Francisco, Bachelors in Public Administration (Law Enforcement Leadership emphasis)
- Golden Gate University School of Law, Juris Doctorate (Law, Specialization in Real Estate Law)

Professional Experience:

- Safety and Security Management - I have designed, implemented and managed various private sector safety and security program for some of the largest corporations in Silicon Valley; including large scale emergency planning and preparedness.
- Attorney - I am a licensed attorney. When active, I provided litigation services and provided legal counsel for clients in the areas of real estate and civil law. I also specialized for a time in representation of public safety employees regarding discipline, officer involved shootings, and contract negotiations.
- Real Estate Broker - As a real estate attorney, I became involved in the business of real estate and ultimately became a broker. I worked in sales and did it full time for a bit before the mortgage crisis.
- Deputy Sheriff (Alameda County) - After graduating the police academy, I spent about 7 years as a sworn peace officer.
- US Navy - I enlisted and served in the Navy as an Aviation Electrician deployed to Operation Desert Storm.

Other Experience:

- CERT - I am active member of the Morgan Hill CERT program. I am also organizing a business CERT program for Amazon and the surrounding businesses.

The diversity of my background gives me a unique perspective on issues. I have learned to think outside the box to find solutions to problems. I have learned how to draft, interpret and review legal documents. I know to look at the effects of decisions a government body makes in order to anticipate legal challenges and unintended consequences.

Lastly, I am fair and balanced in my approach to governing. I realize Morgan Hill is a community with a diverse population and all factions of our community must be considered when making a decision, which takes an open mind and community outreach to find comprehensive solutions that are sustainable.

3. What are your top three priorities for the City of Morgan Hill?

1. Growth - My first priority is growth. As part of Silicon Valley, growth is inevitable. However, growth needs to occur in a responsible and controlled manner. Growth cannot happen without corresponding growth of public services, infrastructure and public education. The need for Measure 'S' in the last election was because growth in Morgan Hill threatened to outpace the communities inability to kepp up with needed infratructure. I want to work towards finding solutions to Morgan Hill's infrastructure to growth issues. Even with a cap on the population and building, we still need to grow our support structure, as well as look to beyond 2035.
2. Education / Infrastructure - With children just beginning their education careers, education is a very important issue. I commend the boldness of our current education programs as my oldest has started kindergarten at JAMM. As our city grows, we will need to find bold solutions to grow our school district. We want good families to come here and find top rated schools. In addition, growth demands strong infrastructure solutions to service our growing population; such as health services, roads, emergency preparations, etc. This requires trimming fat from budgets and finding bold an innovative ways to increase revenue.
3. Revitalization of Downtown - I love our little downtown. I do not want to lose the family friendly vibe we have but want to see it further developed. Together, and with proper planning, we can develop a downtown destination that will attract and add to our community's appeal.

4. Why should you be appointed to serve on the Morgan Hill City Council?

Aside from my education, professional and life experiences as noted in this application, there are a great many more intimate reasons.

First, I am a dedicated family man with two young children. My wife and I chose to have and raise our family in Morgan Hill. Thus, I am as dedicated to Morgan Hill as I am to my family.

Second, I not only listen but I work very hard to hear those around me with problems. All too often, leaders listen to their constituents but do not hear the issues. I work very hard to listen and hear what is being conveyed so I can first identify all the issues in order to come up with sustainable solutions.

Third, I am a reflective person. In other words, I think about the issues, consider possible solutions, and identify and address intended and unintended consequences before moving forward on a problem. Sometimes, this requires thinking outside the norms but the result is usual a longer lasting and more comprehensive solution than knee-jerk reactions.

In short, I care about Morgan Hill, the community it serves and the sense of family values that make Morgan Hill the desirable place to live.



1. Why do you want to be appointed to the City of Morgan Hill City Council?

I have spent my entire life helping people. Whether it was putting out a fire, responding to a medical call, or simply giving directions to someone who was lost, it was my calling for 37 years. After retiring from the fire service, I became more in touch with the political environment especially here in Morgan Hill.

I have listened to people on both sides of the aisle. For instance, I heard people who want Morgan Hill to go back in time 30 years while others are very progressive and want to turn our downtown into a new Santana Row. I have listened to people argue about spiders and simply not understand how it came to be or why did we waste so much money on building a new garage to begin with.

Working with County Fire, I dealt with several cities all having different modes of operations including Morgan Hill. Last year I joined Leadership Morgan Hill so I could learn more about this city and how it operates. It became important for me to become involved with Morgan Hill. Eventhough I have only lived here for 7 years it has really become my home and I want to see this city prosper. It became my goal to become a member of the Morgan Hill City Council.

2. What qualifies you to serve on the Morgan Hill City Council?

I come from a unique background. I served the citizens of California by working in local and state government for 37 years. I spent 7 years with Cal Fire working as a firefighter and forester. As a forester my job was to deal with individual cities where I managed the contracts for Tree City USA. I also spent 30 years as a firefighter/engineer - Hazardous Materials Specialist with the Santa Clara County Fire Department. Priority 3.5: Communication: Getting information out and understanding incoming information. I keep hearing that Morgan Hill arguably has the best in community communication and want to make sure it continues to be the best, both outgoing and incoming.


