AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MORGAN HILL AMENDING SECTION 10.40.210 OF CHAPTER 10.40 OF TITLE 10 OF THE MORGAN HILL MUNICIPAL CODE TO CLARIFY THAT THE PROVISIONS OF THE SECTION APPLY TO THE PARKING OF OVERSIZED VEHICLES ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS

WHEREAS, the provisions of this Ordinance are categorically exempt from review under the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 ("CEQA"), specifically pursuant to Section 15301 of the CEQA Guidelines, involving the regulation and operation of public streets and highways with no expansion of their use; and

WHEREAS, prior to the adoption of this Ordinance, the City Council of the City of Morgan Hill held a duly noticed public hearing at which all interested persons were afforded an opportunity to be heard upon the adoption of this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MORGAN HILL DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 10.40.210 of Chapter 10.40 of Title 10 of the Morgan Hill Municipal Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

10.40.210 Parking Oversized Vehicles On Public Streets in Residential Areas

- A. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 10.40.140, no person shall stop, stand or park an oversized vehicle on a public street or highway located immediately adjacent to real property located in a residential zone, as shown on the official zoning map of the City as may be amended from time to time, except for the purpose of loading or unloading food, supplies, equipment or cargo or due to a temporary and unplanned inoperability. Such exemption period shall not exceed ten (10) consecutive hours.
- B. For the purposes of this section, the term "oversized vehicle" shall mean any vehicle or combination of vehicles that exceeds twenty-two (22) feet in length or seven (7) feet in height, exclusive of any projecting lights or devices allowed by the provisions of the California Vehicle Code.

<u>Section 2</u>. Severability. Should any provision of this Ordinance be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, unenforceable or inapplicable to a situation by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or the applicability of this Ordinance to other situations, and any such invalid or unconstitutional provision shall be severed from this Ordinance, which severance shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date; Posting. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after

the date of its passage and adoption. The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish in full or summary this ordinance in accordance with the provisions of California Government Code section 36933.
