

PROJECT DESCRIPTION
VOICES COLLEGE BOUND ACADEMIES (“VOICES”)
PROPOSED JUAN HERNANDEZ DRIVE CAMPUS
MORGAN HILL, CA

Voices proposes to purchase an approximate 3 acre portion of the Health Trust Land on Juan Hernandez Drive in Morgan Hill, CA (Santa Clara County APN# 817-09-039 and 817-09-041). Voices would construct a public, tuition free elementary charter school on the site that would initially serve approximately 250 students in grades TK-4. The enrollment is expected to grow over a 5 year period and the school would eventually serve 505 students in grades TK-8. At full enrollment there would be approximately 52 staff members and 10-15 parent volunteers.

The school would operate from 7:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. with occasional use on evenings and weekends. Student drop-off would take place from 7:30-8 A.M. and pick-up would take place from 4:00-4:15 P.M. Operating hours and drop-off and pick-up hours could be adjusted to accommodate traffic from nearby uses.

There would be several buildings containing approximately 22,000 square feet of classroom space and approximately 6,300 square feet of administrative and multi-use space. There would also be outside play and shade structures, recreational areas, parking areas and a dedicated drop off and pick up zone.

Voices was founded in 2007 and is one of the highest performing dual language schools in California. They currently operate 3 schools; 2 in San Jose and 1 in Morgan Hill. The Morgan Hill school opened in September, 2015 at the Advent Lutheran Church on Murphy Avenue and currently serves 140 students in grades T-K -2.
