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Dear Morgan Hill City Council,

I am not happy that the City might have to spend up to \$351,000 on a special election. But I am even less happy with the Council picking someone to represent all of our residents for 2 full years.

For whatever reason, Mr. Siebert denied our residents the ability to directly express their choice for three council seats. Since no appointment will likely satisfy everyone, I suggest that the current vacancy be filled by lottery from the candidates who chose to run for Council but did not get elected, with a term only until an election can be held in June 2017.

Re-elected incumbents have been quoted in the local paper as saying their re-election shows that our residents are satisfied with their performance. Those of us that wanted new eyes and new ideas reply that the person receiving the most votes for Council was not an incumbent, that thousands of votes were cast for candidates that did not win a Council seat, and that one out of every three votes cast for Mayor were not for the incumbent.

As staff points out, the estimated cost for a special election could be reduced if there are other agencies within Santa Clara County that will need a special election in June 2017.
