PLANNING COMMISSION The Planning Commission performs duties and exercises power and authority with regard to planning subdivisions, zoning, zoning administration, residential development control, and other land use regulator controls as prescribed by ordinance and state law. The Commission serves as an advisory body to the City Counc on Zoning and General Plan related matters. The Commission is a seven member body, and each commissions serves a term of four years and meets on the second and fourth Tuesday each month.
