As a resident of Morgan Hill, I am in support of the Morgan Hill City Council partnering with the Morgan Hill Historical Society to provide ongoing funding for the development, preservation and maintenance of Villa Mira Monte History Park. Villa Mira Monte and the Hiram Morgan Hill House, our City's National Registered Landmark were developed and built by our city's namesake in 1884. Also on the site is the Morgan Hill Museum, which archives our area history and the Centennial History Trail. Because this historical status requires that the property and house be maintained into perpetuity for community educational and recreation benefits, it is time for the City Council to partner with the Morgan Hill Historical Society in providing financial support.

The most critical funding need from this year's City budget is Phase I of a Development Project to provide storm water infrastructure, pave the driveway and parking area, and landscape the back of the site. Cost projection for this phase is \$1.2 million dollars. Additional phases for future development will require an estimated \$1.8 million in funds to provide structures that will maximize educational and recreational benefits for our community, and provide for additional rental opportunities to fund the site.

Mayor Tate and Council Members,

Morgan Hill is the envy of most Santa Clara County medium sized towns and communities. Our community based buildings and recreational facilities are the very best in our Region. I have looked at other cities of our size and larger and have found that preservation of historically significant land and buildings is central to their goals in providing a place for promoting why we are here and saving what we have.

One looks at New Almaden, Kelly Park in San Jose and Jack London Square in Oakland and feels the importance of our past in saving these wonderful glimpses of where we came from and how we as towns were founded. When I moved here in 1989 I thought as many did that El Toro was Morgan Hill, and fell in love with our downtown and it's eclectic mix of old and new.

Then I became interested in the fact that Morgan Hill was a real person and that our town along with Madrone, San Marin and Gilroy sat along a stage coach trail as well as the El Camino Real, with the Missions.

I must admit it took a bit of time for me to realize what Villa Mira Monte really means to our residents and how truly amazing the House and Museum are in telling our story and instilling a sense of place in our unique city. This house and museum open our eyes to what an amazing place Morgan Hill has become and will become in the future, through eyes from the past. I wonder how Diana Murphy and Hiram Morgan Hill feel about their settlement now, and like to think they would be so grateful that we preserved their home in tribute to the past and the hard work they did in settling here.

We have a responsibility to maintain these houses and the contents that represent our founding. Once I joined the Historical Society and realized how much has been accomplished with so little by a handful of women that are passionate about preserving our past, I was drawn into the past and decided to help with the infrastructure upgrades and improvements to show my gratitude to those that have worked so long and hard preserving the past for all of us in Morgan Hill.

I was also very surprised to learn that the City has no budget or funding for the maintenance of this property let alone the funding for long term improvements. I found very little in the past and present agenda's for the Parks and Recreation involvement regarding this issue.

We would like to propose that the Parks and Recreation Commission along with the Morgan Hill City Council begin the conversation regarding permanent funding not only for the day to day operations, but for the long term improvements that will allow many more of our residents to become actively involved in community events and activities held there. The most crucial of these improvements is the widening and paving of the access/egress driveways and leveling and paving for parking.

We need to nurture this link to our past, and give our history the support and preservation it deserves. Thank you all for taking the time to read this letter.

## OBJECTIVE

To show community support that acknowledges support for City Council decisions to allocate funds to support Villa Mira Monte preservation and capital maintenance. To develop a community partnership that provides for ongoing use of City resources, where it makes sense, to support the operation and routine maintenance of Villa Mira Monte.

The first petition collected in-person signatures. We then set up a request for letters through Constant Contact and including a form letter that could be customized. An online petition was developed to collect responses from our larger contact base.
