NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Wednesday, March 1, 2017, a public hearing as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 will be held with respect to the proposed issuance by the California Municipal Finance Authority of its revenue bonds in one or more series in an amount not to exceed \$26,000,000 (the "Bonds"). The proceeds of the Bonds will be used to: (1) finance the acquisition and rehabilitation of a 112 unit multifamily housing development (the "Project") located at 16480 Del Monte Avenue in the City of Morgan Hill, County of Santa Clara, California; and (2) pay certain expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds. The Project is to be owned and operated by EAH Park Place, L.P., a limited partnership or another limited partnership to be formed by EAH Inc. or a related entity, and is to be occupied, in part or in whole, by persons or families of low or very low income. The Bonds and the obligation to pay principal of and interest thereon and any redemption premium with respect thereto do not constitute indebtedness or an obligation of the Authority, the State of California or any political subdivision thereof, within the meaning of any constitutional or statutory debt limitation, or a charge against the general credit or taxing powers of any of them. The Bonds shall be a limited obligation of the Authority, payable solely from certain revenues duly pledged therefor and generally representing amounts paid by the Borrower. The hearing will commence at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, and will be held in the Plaza Conf. Rm./Council Chambers, 2nd Fl., City Hall, 17555 Peak Avenue, Morgan Hill, California. Interested persons wishing to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds or on the nature and location of the facilities proposed to be financed may attend the public hearing or, prior to the time of the hearing, submit written comments.
